Our Ophthalmology service also conducts regular BVA/KC/ISDS EYE testing sessions. Additionally, we have a 1.5T MRI, a state-of-the-art CT scanner, digital radiography, and high-end ultrasound units. An inhouse laboratory with a cytology microscope is also available. We collaborate extensively with other services within the hospital to optimize patient care.
