Excellent interpersonal and communication skills and a demonstrated ability to work with others in a collegial team atmosphere, and an aptitude for and desire to teach and mentor veterinary students and house officers is required. Eligibility for veterinary licensure (or faculty certificate) in the State of North Carolina is also required. Preference will be given to candidates with ACVO or ECVO Diplomate status.
