ECVO Residency in Veterinary Ophthalmology

The Small Animal Hospital of the University of Veterinary Medicine Hannover, Foundation is looking for a highly motivated veterinarian to join our ophthalmology team for a three-year ECVO Residency Training Programme, starting in May 2027.

Our ophthalmology team currently consists of two ECVO Diplomates, one residency-trained clinician, one resident, three veterinarians training for the national ophthalmology certificate and a dedicated ophthalmology nurse. We offer a friendly, supportive and collaborative working environment with a strong focus on excellent patient care, teaching and research.

As a resident, you will be involved in the diagnosis and medical and surgical treatment of ophthalmic patients and participate in the ophthalmology on-call service. The position also includes opportunities to contribute to research projects and scientific publications, as well as teaching veterinary students and junior clinicians.

Our hospital is well equipped with modern diagnostic and surgical facilities, including MRI and spectral CT. Close collaboration with other clinical and non-clinical departments gives us access to a wide range of expertise, equipment and research facilities, creating excellent opportunities for interdisciplinary research.

We are looking for a veterinarian with a genuine interest in ophthalmology and a desire to develop a career in this field. You should be qualified to practise veterinary medicine in the European Union and have completed a rotating internship or have at least two years of clinical experience in small animal medicine. Previous experience in ophthalmology is desirable, but not essential. We particularly value curiosity, willingness to learn, good organisational and teamwork skills, and enthusiasm for working in an interdisciplinary environment. German language skills at B2 level or higher are required for communication with clients.
