### **Anonymous polls**

- To understand who is present
- To identify any training difficulties

#### **Activities**


- Approve new RTPs
- Assess each resident & monitor progress annually
- Certify completion of RTPs
- Maintain Information Brochure & Online Forms System
- Implement necessary changes

### **Approval of RTPs**

- Assess all planned components of training
- Ensure aligned to ECVO guidelines (Information Brochure)
- Do <u>NOT</u> approve the candidate resident
- Approval obtained from Credentials Committee
- Allow 3 months to get this
- RTP cannot start until after this is received
- Best to get approval of candidate before apply to ERC if possible!

### **Application for RTP**

- Should be made by Programme Director
  - Not proposed resident
- Final approval withheld until proposed resident has been identified and approved by Credentials Committee
- Read Information Brochure first!
- Complete Form 2
- Turnaround usually < 4 weeks</li>
- Allow 3 months for new Programme Directors/Institutions




### **Approval of RTP**


- Issued to Programme Director
- Certification of Approval
  - Includes details of Information Brochure followed
  - May include conditions
- Form 3
  - To confirm RTP started and confirm resident contact details
- Summary of requirements
  - How to gain access to online forms system



#### Online forms submission

- Submit COMPLETE forms within one month of completion of a year's training (or equivalent)
  - Use comments boxes to express any problems
- Lock forms of that year
- Processed within one month
  - Reviewed by 3 members, collated by Chair (or co-Chair)
- Corrections and clarifications are likely
  - Request to unlock forms (only need to do it once!)
  - Complete within one month
  - Use comments box
- Once forms classed as 'ok' no further action is required
  - (No need to unlock forms of that year)

#### Some advice...

- Advise 3-6 monthly progress meetings
  - Identify any training deficits
  - Identify both sides happy with progress
- Advise supervisor to check forms regularly and before submission
- Ensure there are no resident/supervisor discrepancies
- Regular timetabled journal club/book club
- Regular cadaver training (especially for rare surgeries)

#### Reminder of deadlines

- Approval of RTP completion (Submission of online forms)
  - 1st August
- Application to Credentials Committee
  - 1st September
- Application to Examination Committee
  - 1<sup>st</sup> December

# Final year forms

- August 1<sup>st</sup> is a <u>DEADLINE</u> not a <u>TARGET</u>
- Submit forms as soon as complete
- Early submission of forms
  - Eligible if RTP ends before Dec 1st
- Explain any deficiencies using comments boxes (e.g. missing of surgery numbers)
- You <u>MUST</u> have have achieved minimal training to obtain a Certificate of Training Completion
- You cannot apply to Credentials Committee without it (deadline September 1<sup>st</sup>)

### **ERC Updates**

- HED case logs
  - Introduced June 2019
  - Remember to include clinical cases, photographic and slide material

#### COVID

- Use comments boxes in online forms system to explain disruption
- Outline plans to overcome disruption
- All requirements still need to be met over 3 years

#### **Discussion**

- Richard McMullen (Scientific Committee)
  - 1. Encouraged residents not to wait on submitting abstracts for presentation in the final year of residency as competition has increased
  - 2. Advised that, in future, abstracts not submitted in correct format will be rejected without opportunity to resubmit
- Corrina Eule
  - Suggested considering allowing residents to present at conferences other than ECVO and ACVO
- Richard McMullen (Scientific Committee)
  - Pointed out that 23/30 oral presentations this year were from residents
- Simon Pot
  - Queried whether capacity could be increased without reducing quality
- Teresa Pena (Credentials Committee)
  - Advised that this has been an unprecedented year with many presentations submitted for the cancelled 2020 conference being carried over
- James Oliver (Educations & Residency Committee)
  - Asked if parallel streams of abstracts could be possible
