

The SeeVet Referrals of Roma, Italy, is offering a one-year clinical Ophthalmology Internship under the guidance of an experienced board-certified specialist, Dr. Nunzio D'Anna (Dipl ECVO, PhD). There is no application deadline and we will accept applications until the position is filled.

The SeeVet Referrals of Roma is a veterinary ophthalmic referral center that operate in a great area located very close to the beautiful roman hills called "Castelli Romani".

Ideal candidate is a veterinarian with a strong interest in Ophthalmology. The candidate will be part of the Ophthalmology team with an ECVO diplomate, an ECVO resident and support staff. A large focus will be on providing inpatient care and supporting the ophthalmology clinicians during the daily medical and surgical caseload.

The goal of the internship is to prepare the intern to apply for an ECVO residency. The majority of the intern's time will be devoted to clinical work of ophthalmic cases. The intern should expect mentoring to be focused on the development of proficiency in diagnostic and therapeutic veterinary ophthalmology including an introduction to surgical ophthalmology in preparation for the hands-on surgical training reserved for a residency program. Depending on the ongoing studies, an intern might be invited to form part of a research project.

At the end of his Internship program, the candidate will be highly considered for a residency program, of 3-years duration, which follows the guidelines of the European College of Veterinary Ophthalmology (ECVO) and provides the prerequisites for subsequent board certification.

Requirements:

- DMV, DVM, VMD or equivalent degree, eligible to register to the Ordine dei Medici Veterinari di Roma.
- Veterinarian in good standing without encumbrance in the jurisdiction of any EU country.
- Completion of a 12-month rotating veterinary internship, preferably, or at least 2 years period working as clinician in private practice.
- Applicants must be citizens of an EU member country or a permanent resident of an EU member country.
- A personal letter of intent including reasons for applying to the internship and career goals.
- Recent photograph
- Current curriculum vitae.

- One letter of recommendation that should be sent directly to ndanna@libero.it . The letters should not be forwarded by the applicant.
- Medium level of Italian or Spanish (with the goal to learn Italian) and English are required.
- We consider to offer a short, unpaid externship/interview to the candidates to better know each others.
